

Goal of Harbor District's Harbor Fest

Harbor Fest reintroduces Milwaukee to its harbor and brings community together to experience the revitalization of the waterfront with a free, family-friendly street festival that celebrates all things fish and boats.

For a long time, this area was seen as “off limits” or unwelcoming. Harbor Fest will change that as the community comes together to enjoy the place where our three rivers come together.

Harbor View Plaza

A new public plaza on the east end of Greenfield Avenue will be open by Harbor Fest 2019. It is the first major investment in what will eventually be a continuous network of HarborWalk and waterfront parks spanning the western shore of the Harbor District.

Harbor View Plaza will include a children's play structure, water play area with water feature, and a canoe/kayak launch. The play structure will be designed to look like a shipping container, synonymous with ports around the world. Children will be able to explore water flow and cool off on hot days.

The canoe/kayak launch and dock will allow visitors to get to the water's edge and provide the only public launch and dock south of the Milwaukee River in Milwaukee's Inner Harbor.
